A basic knowledge of Art & Design plus skills in the use of the formal elements are desirable. Obviously a general interest in the subject and enthusiasm and commitment are also important factors.

The following option is offered:

ART AND DESIGN (Unendorsed) – 3201

A broad and varied course, incorporating drawing, painting, 3 D work (where possible), mixed media and printmaking.

At the end of the course students must submit between 2 – 4 units of coursework. This forms 60% of the total marks.

In addition to the coursework, candidates sit a 10 hour controlled test in response to questions set by the exam board. This forms 40% of the total marks.

Both coursework and controlled test must be completed to gain a grade at GCSE.
